These microfilm reels contained the "North Bend Argus" Reels A & 1 and the "North Bend Republican" Reels A & 1. In some instances the vital statistic information was duplicated in both newspapers.

For the precise dates of the occurrences "The Argus" came out weekly on Thursday, "The Republican" came out on Friday, and the North Bend Eagle came out on Thursday. The parenthesis at the end of each entry makes reference to the reel number and my own page numbering system. These page numbers refer to the Xerox copy of the actual page of the North Bend newspaper recorded in the particular microfilm reel.

The obits and marriages, between the years 1890 and 1942 are not by any means complete but are missing a large number due to missing newspaper copies)
